OBJECTIVE:

The Quality Dividend Focus Defensive (QDF Defensive) Portfolio is designed to provide consistent and systematic exposure to high-quality, dividend-paying securities while avoiding risks that we believe to be uncompensated. The strategy is a capital preservation and income growth strategy and is suited for income-oriented investors seeking a defensive portfolio approach.

INVESTMENT APPROACH:

The Quality Dividend Focus Defensive strategy is designed to deliver a high-quality, income-oriented portfolio emphasizing capital preservation. Our research concludes that high quality companies tend to outperform over time. Additionally, our research shows that high dividend yielding stocks have historically outperformed broad market benchmarks. We believe that the combination of high quality and high dividend yielding stocks can provide positive relative returns over the long-term.

Our methodology consists of three categories of fundamental factors (profitability, management, and cash factors) that we believe differentiate a security's level of quality. Portfolios are constructed to take active exposures by overweighting and underweighting securities based on their dividend yield and relative quality rankings. Risks that are not consistently rewarded such as market timing, sector and style tilting are minimized. The intent is to invest in companies that are priced attractively based on their expected dividend payment, and that exhibit strong business fundamentals, solid management and reliable cash flow. The portfolio has a defensive focus with a Beta that is approximately 20% lower than the market Beta and is expected to perform relatively well in downward trending markets.

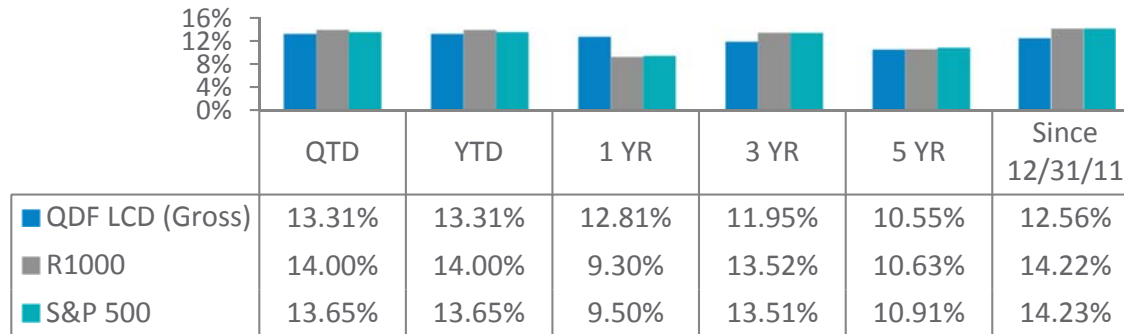

This benchmark replaced the prior benchmark the S&P 500® Index, effective 7/1/14 as it is the more appropriate benchmark for the QDF Defensive strategy.
